The Team Sponsor is permitted to have different players in his Team on the second day of the tournament.

The tournament will be played under PGA Tournament rules.

STARTING TIMES

Will all Competitors please register at PGA Reception 15 minutes before their Official Starting Time.

DRESS

Smart Casual dress is allowed in the Clubhouse & Dining Room.

MEALS

Players may have a meal before or after playing, extra meals should be paid for.

AMATEUR PRIZES

Overall (36 hole total) and separate daily prizes.
